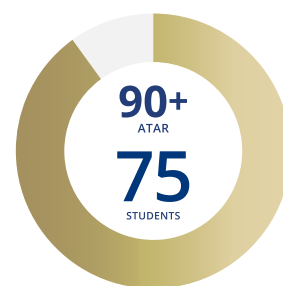
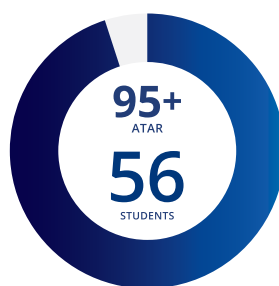
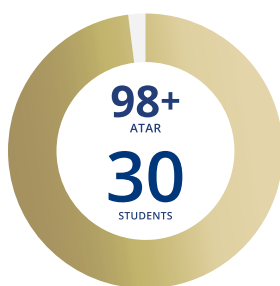
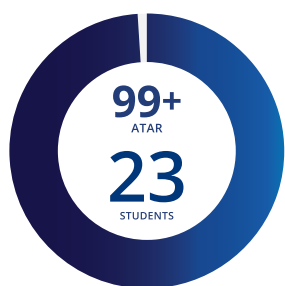


# Higher School Certificate and International Baccalaureate Results 2021

Dear Redlands Parents and Carers

With the HSC results released this week, we now congratulate the entire Class of 2021 on their exceptional results in the HSC and IB examinations. From a cohort of 138 students:

- 17% of students achieved an ATAR of 99 or more
- 22% of students achieved an ATAR of 98 or more
- 41% of students achieved an ATAR of 95 or more
- 54% of students achieved an ATAR of 90 or more
- 75% of students achieved an ATAR of 80 or more
- 91% of students achieved an ATAR of 70 or more

Having recognised the International Baccalaureate Top Achievers earlier this month, we now make special mention of the following HSC Top Achievers, with two 1st in State awards:

- **Carmen Brisson**, who placed 1st in Course for Spanish Extension, 3rd in Course for Textiles & Design and achieved top band results in nine of her units and an ATAR of 96.05
- **Gabrielle Drage**, who placed 1st in Course for Textiles and Design, achieved top band results in eight of her units and an ATAR of 97.15
- **Toby Griffiths**, who achieved top band results in nine of his units and an ATAR of 95.95
- **Amelia Ford**, who achieved top band results in five of her units and an ATAR of 96.05
- **Paula Sampaio Little**, who placed 4th in Course for Portuguese Continuers, achieved top band results in five of her units and an ATAR of 90.5.

At Redlands, our students have the flexibility to develop their individual pathway to academic success through the choice of the Higher School Certificate or International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme. The combined academic achievements of the entire Class of 2021, both HSC and IB, are highlighted in the following pages.

We thank all students for their outstanding contribution to Redlands during their time at the School and wish them all the very best as they embark on their post school pathways. We also sincerely thank all their teachers, along with parents and carers, for their guidance, care and support.

At this time we remind parents and carers that the statistics and ranking reports that will appear in the media this week only reflect the achievements of 50% of the Class of 2021 who undertook the HSC and do not include the achievements of our IB students. This summary provides the full and comprehensive picture of the academic achievements and success of the Class of 2021.
