In addition to the above fees, students who are not Australian residents and are classified as Full Fee Paying Overseas Students (FFPOS) are required to pay the following fees prior to their commencement at Redlands:

- A non-refundable Application Fee of \$330.
- A non-refundable Enrolment Fee of \$4,000 or \$2000 for the second or any subsequent children from the same family.
- A Term's Tuition Fee in advance. This is held to pay for the student's final Term's Tuition Fee at the School (at which time the parent will be required to pay the difference between the final Term's Fees and this amount).

Year 12 Levy

A 'once off' levy of \$1,345 is imposed by the NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA) on FFPOS who are candidates for the Higher School Certificate. This item is added to Term 3 statements for Year 12 students, and is not included in the Tuition Fees. Please note that this Fee may be subject to change by the New South Wales Board of Studies.

Discounts Available

Early Payment Terms

A discount of 2.5%, of core tuition fees only is available when the payment of annual tuition fees is received in full on or before 16 January 2026.

Sibling Discount (in descending age order)

- 2nd child 2.5% discount
- 3rd child 5% discount
- 4th child 50% discount
- 5th child 70% discount

Sibling discounts apply only to core Tuition Fees and are only available whilst siblings are concurrently enrolled at the School.

1. Tuition Fees and Other Charges Billing

Annual Tuition Fees

Annual Tuition Fees are billed in full at the beginning of Term 1 each year and paid in full or through a selected payment plan of either weekly, fortnightly, monthly or termly, via VCPay.

Other Charges

Other charges are billed on a termly basis with automatic payment via VCPay. A schedule of automatic payment dates and due dates is available on Pulse.

Full Fee Paying Overseas Students (FFPOS)

Full Fee Paying Overseas Students (FFPOS) pay a higher scale of fees incorporating but not limited to Commonwealth and State Per Capita Grant equivalents. These are detailed in a separate FFPOS Schedule of Fees document.

2. Payment Methods

All families are required to register with VCPay, the Veracross integrated payment platform, for the management and payment of Tuition Fees and Other Charges.

3. Resource and Activity Fee

From 2026, a consolidated Resource and Activity Fee will be charged and invoiced in two equal instalments on Term 1 and Term 3 invoices.

This charge is tailored to each Year Group and consolidates the various curriculum and cocurricular ancillary charges previously billed to families throughout the year, including but are not limited to: subscriptions and licenses, in-hours curricular and cocurricular excursions and incursions, Student Diaries, Class/School photos, MIP Program equipment hire and books, subject specific resources such as Visual Arts Diaries and pencils, Junior School books and stationery packs.

Exclusions from the Resource and Activity Fee include but are not limited to items such as lost library books, experiential and multi-day programs, optional trips/tours and holiday programs, IB charges, school bus, sports, extracurricular activities or private tuition.

4. Technology Charge

A Technology Levy will be included on Term 1 2026 invoices for Year 5 and Year 7 students as the School transitions to school-managed devices. The Levy includes a MacBook Air for Year 7 and an iPad for Year 5 students along with all required accessories, maintenance and onsite repair support, software licensing and security, technical support and insurance.

This program will expand gradually to other Year Groups and include all students by 2031.

5. Program Charges

In addition to Tuition Fees, charges associated to Redlands experiential learning programs and curriculum offerings are as follows:

** Optional programs

Moonbah Residential Program

A bespoke nine-week residential experience, the Moonbah Program is undertaken by all Year 9 students in either Term 1 or Term 2 at the Redlands High Country Campus (HCC), Jindabyne.

The charge for this program will be billed in full in either Term 1 or Term 2, depending on student attendance, and covers the 7-day week program as well as all catering, boarding and activities.

Arnhem Land Immersion Program

A cultural immersion program is undertaken by all Year 10 students each year, in partnership with Culture College, in Arnhem Land.

The charge for this program will be billed in full in Term 2.

Winter School

Winter School is a ten-week residential program based at the Redlands High Country Campus (HCC), Jindabyne. It operates during Term 3 and is optional for Year 10 students.

The charge for this program will be billed in full in Term 3.

International Baccalaureate (IB) Elective Fee

Students undertaking the elective IB Diploma Programme will be charged a fee to cover the additional cost of the IB Diploma Programme Workshop, IBO Examination Fee and costs associated with delivering the IB program.

The fee of \$2,950 per annum for this elective program is payable for students in both Year 11 IB and Year 12 IB. This fee is billed in Term 1 of each year.

Withdrawal from the IB program is subject to the 'Notice of Withdrawal/Early Departure' clause contained in the School's Terms and Conditions and no refunds will be made for any IB Elective Fee paid.

6. Extra-Curricular Activities

Fees for extra-curricular activities are published separately via the Redlands Pulse page for each activity area; refer to individual application forms for full details and conditions. These fees are generally billed on a half-yearly basis, at the beginning of Term 2 and Term 4. OOSH fees are billed monthly, at the end of each month.

7. Scholarship, Building and Library Fund Donations

8. Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Most school activities and educational services are exempt from the goods and services tax (GST). In the event the School becomes liable to GST, it reserves the right to recover any additional amount payable on account of GST.

9. Credit Card Surcharge

Surcharges are applicable if paying tuition or incidental fees using a credit or debit card. Paying via a bank account incurs no additional cost. The surcharge will be charged in full at the time of payment via the VCPay Platform.

10. Withdrawal from the School

A full term's notice in writing must be given to the Principal before any student is removed from the School during or at the end of Terms 1, 2 or 3. If this notice is not given, a term's fees and charges plus GST are payable.

Two full term's notice in writing must be given to the Principal before any student is removed from the School during or at the end of Term 4. If this notice is not given, a term's fees and charges plus GST are payable.

The final dates for notice for departures during or at the end of each term are as follows:

Term 1	16 January 2026	Term 3	26 June 2026
Term 2	2 April 2026	Term 4	24 July 2026

This notice period is required to enable the School to identify and enrol a replacement student and therefore minimise loss of income to the School.

When providing notice of withdrawal, under current NSW Education Standards Authority requirements, the parent/carer must provide the name of the school to which their child/ren is/are being transferred.

11. Conditions of Enrolment

This document should be read in conjunction with the Conditions of Entry and Continuing Enrolment that were signed prior to commencement. Annual changes in fees do not constitute a change in Conditions of Entry or Continuing Enrolment terms and conditions.

12. Changes in Government Education Funding

The Board reserves the right to adjust pre-published fees at any time in response to changes in government education funding.
