

# School Uniform

The following guidelines are designed to support students in wearing the Redlands School Uniform with pride and consistency.

**Uniform:** All students must be wearing the new uniform from the first day of Term 1 2026.

**Normal Usage:** When travelling to and from School, when on excursion or when involved in any activity associated with the School, students will wear full school uniform as set out below.

**Maintenance:** Students may be sent to the Uniform Shop to correct outstanding/non-compliant pieces of uniform. Students who are required to purchase correct items will be charged accordingly.

## Lost Property and Labelling Requirements:

- All uniform items must be clearly named
- The School is not responsible for lost items
- Unclaimed items after each semester will be donated/disposed of

## Uniform

### Blazers, Jumpers and Jerseys

- Blazers must be worn to and from school during Terms 2 and 3 and are optional during Terms 1 and 4
- Jumpers are not to be worn as the outer garment to and from school, all year round
- Year 12 students are not to wear their jerseys to and from school as their outer garment, all year round
- Blazers are compulsory for formal events as advised throughout the year including but not limited to Speech Day/Night, Foundation Day, School Photograph Day
- Redlands Puffer Vest may be worn under the blazer

### Shirts

- Shirts must be tucked in when wearing skirts, pants or shorts
- Additional layers under shirts should not be visible (eg. thermal tops must be white/navy/nude and not visible)

### Dresses/Skirts

- Hems are to sit at the top of knees
- Skirts are not to be rolled up at the top

### Ties

- Ties are optional for everyday wear
- Ties must be worn by boys, and are optional for girls, on formal events as advised, including but not limited to Speech Day/Night, Foundation Day, School Photograph Day

### Shoes

- Polished black laced, leather, black-soled school shoes (not leather trainers)

### Hats

- A Redlands SunSmart hat is optional; however, hats and sunscreen are recommended for all students

### Accessories

- Redlands School backpack
- Redlands Sports bag
- Redlands Tote bag

## Other

- Socks – navy, Redlands only
- Tights – navy, Redlands only
- Belts – black belt with silver buckle must be worn with pants and shorts
- Scarves – Redlands scarf only
- Raincoats – navy, grey or black without any large logos
- Umbrellas – navy or black
- Gloves – navy

## Hair

- Hair is to be styled and tied up neatly so that it is away from eyes, ears and collar
- Longer hair is to be tied back with navy hair ties/ribbons or hair coloured hair ties
- Hair must be of a naturally occurring colour
- Mullet hairstyles are not permitted
- Hair accessories are not to be worn on wrists
- No beards are permitted

## Jewellery

- Students are to wear no more than one pair of understated earrings such as small studs or small thin hoops in the lower lobe of the ear
- Facial or cartilage piercings are not permitted
- Necklaces, bracelets or anklets are not permitted
- A wristwatch may be worn
- Requests to wear cultural, faith-based or medical jewellery must be made by parents or carers to the Year Advisor

## Nails

- No nail polish is allowed other than clear
- Nails are to be clipped to a practical and safe length
- False nails are not permitted

## Make-Up/Other

- Make-up is not permitted
- False eyelashes are not permitted
- Fake tans are not permitted

Please note the uniform expectations around hair, jewellery, nails and make-up are still applicable for Camps, School Trips, Moonbah and Winter School.
